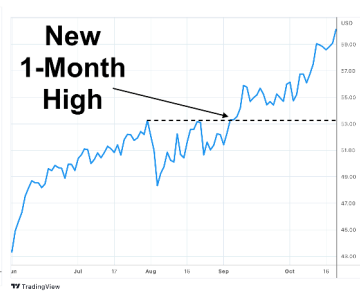

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1. How It Works

This section explains why this report can be used as a Stock Screener and Backtest.

Stock Screener

This report acts as a "**Stock Screener**" because it lists the stocks that in the last trading session showed at least 1 of the following 4 trading signals / chart patterns which identify the potential continuation of a **positive trend** at short, medium or long term:

- Short-Term Trend**
New 2-Week High
- Short / Mid-Term Trend**
New 1-Month High
- Mid-Term Trend**
New 3-Month High
- Long-Term Trend**
New 1-Year High



Backtest

The "**Backtest**" function of this report refers to a **test** carried out on the stocks identified by the *stock screener* to find out how they have performed, in a given period, every time that in the *last 4 years* they have shown the same trading signal / chart pattern. The **basic principle of the backtest** is that every time the trading signal / chart pattern has appeared in the past, it is as if a buy position on the stocks was opened and then closed in 4 different ways: after 20 days, after 60 days, after 120 days or using a strategy that includes a stop loss and a take profit. Backtests do not consider overlapping trades. See "Glossary" for more information.

The image below shows an example of how the backtest results are shown for each stocks analyzed assuming that the stock screener shows that Apple (AAPL), Nvidia (NVDA) and Amazon (AMZN) are the only 3 stocks that in the last trading session have reached the highest price of the last 3 months and it is assumed that the backtest places as a condition for closing the trade that 20 days have elapsed since the opening. The data in the table is not real but just an example.

ENTRY Strategy

It refers to the single trading signal / chart pattern used to simulate the opening of each single trades: New 2-Week, 1-Month, 3-Month and 1-Year High.

EXIT Strategy

It refers to the strategy used to simulate the exit / closing of each single trades: after 20, 60, 120 days or using a strategy with a stop loss of 10% and a take profit of 20%.

No.

It refers to how many trades have been made, i.e. how many times the single trading signal / chart pattern has appeared in the last 4 years.

Positive Trades

It refers to how many trades have closed positively. In the example, Apple Inc (AAPL) stock price has reached a new 3-month high 25 times and in 85% of cases the price after 20 days was higher than the initial price.

Average Return

It refers to the average return of a trades. In the example in each of the 25 times Apple Inc (AAPL) reached a new 3-month high it gained an average of 4% over the next 20 days.

Total Return

It refers to how much an initial portfolio of \$10,000 invested in each individual trades would earn in total. In the example, if you had started with a capital of \$10,000 and invested every time Apple reached a new 3-month high and closed the position 20 days later, you would have gained 266,6% (gross commissions).

2. General: Rankings

Within this report you will find 4 distinct sections that show the results of the backtests, with the relative rankings, for each of the 4 "ENTRY Strategies": New 2-Week High, New 1-Month High, New 3-Month High and New 1-Year High.

In this section, however, you will find **3 rankings** that show the results of the backtests of **all 4 "ENTRY Strategies"** combined together in order to determine the *best strategies* present throughout the report in terms of percentage of positive trades, average return per trade and total return. Backtests do not consider overlapping trades. See "Glossary" for more information.

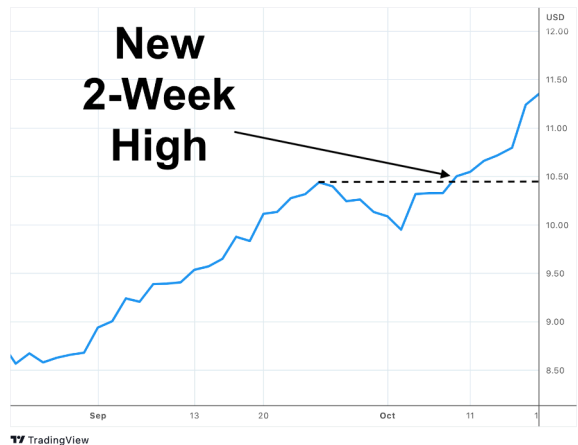
3. New 2-Week High

New 2-Week High

When a company increases in price and exceeds the maximum price reached in the last 2 weeks (10 days) it can continue a positive trend in the short-term.

Then, in this section you will find the results of the backtest of all the stocks that in the last trading session have reached a new 2-week high.

For every time this signal has occurred in the last 4 years, an operation is simulated that ends in 4 different ways: after 20 days, after 60 days, after 120 days and using a strategy with a stop loss of -10% and a take profit of +20%. In the next 3 pages there are the results of the backtest.

Stop loss -10% and Take profit +20%

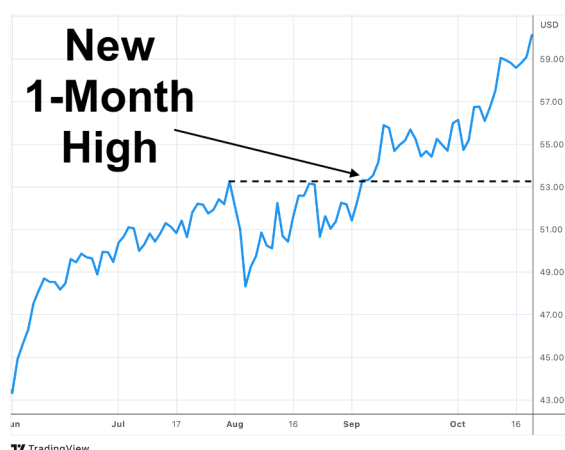

6. New 1-Year High

New 1-Year High

When a company increases in price and exceeds the maximum price reached in the last year (240 days) it can continue a positive trend in the long-term.

Then, in this section you will find the results of the backtest of all the stocks that in the last trading session have reached a new 1-year high.

For every time this signal has occurred in the last 4 years, an operation is simulated that ends in 4 different ways: after 20 days, after 60 days, after 120 days and using a strategy with a stop loss of -10% and a take profit of +20%. In the next 3 pages there are the results of the backtest.

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7. Glossary

New High:

It means that a company's price increases in value until it reaches the highest price of a certain period. In this report the following 4 periods are considered: 2-week, 1-month, 3-month and 1-year.

Backtest:

It represents a test carried out on the historical data of a company. In particular, in this report the backtest is used to understand how a company performed after it showed a certain Trading Signal / Chart Pattern. The basic principle of the backtest is that every time the trading signal / chart pattern has appeared in the past, it is as if a buy position on the stocks was opened and then closed in 4 different ways: after 20 days, after 60 days, after 120 days or using a strategy that includes a stop loss and a take profit.

Trading Signal / Chart Pattern:

This report identifies the price that reached a new high in 2-week, 1-month, 3 month and 1-year.

ENTRY Strategy:

It refers to the single trading signal / chart pattern used to simulate the opening of each single trades: New 2-Week High, New 1-Month High, New 3-Month High and New 1-Year High.

EXIT Strategy:

It refers to the strategy used to simulate the exit / closing of each single trades: after 20, 60, 120 days or using a strategy with a stop loss and a take profit.

No.:

It refers to how many trades have been made, i.e. how many times the single trading signal / chart pattern has appeared in the last 4 years.

Positive Trades:

It refers to how many trades have closed positively. In the example of the "How It Works" section, Apple Inc (AAPL) stock price has reached a new 3-month high 25 times and in 85% of cases the price after 20 days was higher than the initial price.

Average Return:

It refers to the average return of a trades. In the example of the "How It Works" section in each of the 25 times Apple Inc (AAPL) reached a new 3-month high it gained an average of 4% over the next 20 days. All data in this report refer to gross of commissions and other expenses.

Total Return:

It refers to how much an initial portfolio of \$10,000 invested in each individual trades would earn in total. In the example of the "How It Works" section, if you had started with an initial capital of \$10,000 and invested every time Apple reached a new 3-month high and closed the position 20 days later, you would have gained 266, 6%. All data in this report refer to gross of commissions and other expenses.

Stocks / Stocks Analyzed:

Represents all the individual companies analyzed in the report.

Strategies / Strategies Analyzed:

Represents all the strategies analyzed in the report. The single strategy consists of an entry and an exit strategy. For example, 4 strategies are considered if we assume to carry out a backtest with an entry strategy with the price reached a new 3-month high and an exit strategy that considers all 4 periods (after 20, 60, 120 and with stop loss and take profit).

Trades / Trades Analyzed:

Represents all trades analyzed in the report. If we assume that Apple in the last 4 years has reached a new 3-month high 25 times, then the number of trades considered is precisely 25. The total number of trades sums up the trades of Apple and all the other companies analyzed in the report.

Average Top 3 Positive Trades / Average Return/ Total Return:

The calculation starts from the percentage of trades concluded in the positive/average return per trade/total return of the best 3 strategies and makes a simple average of the values.

Stop Loss and Take Profit:

In this report, the stop loss and take profit refer to the end-of-day data. So, if in a simulated trade there is a stop loss of -10% and in the middle of the day it was hitting -12% but it eventually recovers and closes the day at -8%, then the stop loss will not trigger and the trade will not be closed.

NO Overlapping trades:

This concept is very important and refers to the fact that there cannot be simultaneous trades for the same strategy. For example, if the apple price reached a new 3-month high on January 10, the opening of a buy position is simulated. Now let's assume that the trade's closing strategy is 20 days after the opening, so January 30th. Now, if Apple's price reaches a new 3-month high on January 15, a second purchase position on Apple will not be opened, but the original one will remain. Different speech if the apple price reaches a new 3-month high on February 3, then in that case the opening of a new trades will be simulated.

The fact that each closing strategy has a different time before closing the trade means that the number of trades, with the same entry strategy, will be different for the 4 different types of exit strategies. Quite simply it is enough to take the example above, if the exit strategy had been after 60 days instead of after 20, then the fact that the price of apple had reached a new 3-month high on February 15 would have meant that the buy position was not opened because 60 days must pass from the day of purchase to have a second trades.

Obviously these concepts do not apply to the strategy with take profit and stop loss because the opening and closing in that case depend on the achievement of a certain gain or loss and not based on time.

Minimum trades to enter the rankings:

While the "All trades" sections contain the results of the backtests of all the strategies, the "Rankings" sections do not include those that have less than 3 trades made, this is necessary to only have strategies with enough data analyzed to be considered reliable.
