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# 1. SuperTrend: Bullish Reversal

The SuperTrend is a trend-following indicator that indicates the potential start / continuation of a trend and is built to take volatility into account, in fact the ATR (Average True Range) of the last 7 days is used with a multiplier equal to 3 to complete the formula.

When the price of a stock rise above the SuperTrend value it is possible that a positive trend begins / continues (Bullish Reversal).















## 2. SuperTrend: Bearish Reversal

The SuperTrend is a trend-following indicator that indicates the potential start / continuation of a trend and is built to take volatility into account, in fact the ATR (Average True Range) of the last 7 days is used with a multiplier equal to 3 to complete the formula.

When the price of a stock falls below the SuperTrend value it is possible that a negative trend begins / continues (Bearish Reversal).

# 3. MACD: Bullish Reversal

This subsection focuses on the trading signal / chart pattern which refers to the potential **start/continuation of a positive trend** and is identified with the **MACD** crossed above the **Signal line** (Bullish Reversal).

The MACD (Moving Average Convergence Divergence) is the difference between a shorter-term (12-week) and a longer-term (26-week) exponential moving average. Instead the Signal line is given by the 9-week exponential moving average of the MACD.

Therefore, when the MACD crossed above the signal line (and therefore its moving average) a signal is generated that determines the start/continuation of a potential positive trend.

# 4. MACD: Bearish Reversal

This subsection focuses on the trading signal / chart pattern which refers to the potential **start/continuation of a negative trend** and is identified with the **MACD** crossed below the **Signal line** (Bearish Reversal).

The MACD (Moving Average Convergence Divergence) is the difference between a shorter-term (12-week) and a longer-term (26-week) exponential moving average. Instead the Signal line is given by the 9-week exponential moving average of the MACD.

Therefore, when the MACD crossed below the signal line (and therefore its moving average) a signal is generated that determines the start/continuation of a potential negative trend.
